
### MARDI GRAS

Basic quilting supplies

Rotary Cutter, small square ruler (I use a 9-1/2" square) and mat

Favorite Marking tool (I use Chaco-Liner and will have some in class for optional purchase)

**Pins** 

Neutral color thread

PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS SUPPLY LIST IS SHORTENDED to indicate just what is needed for the class.

The fabric and cutting requirements for the entire quilt are on the 2nd page of this supply list.

From the pre-cut fabrics (listed on page 2), please bring the following to class:

### WHITE

- (4) 4-1/2" squares
- (3) Half strips from the 2-1/2" x WOF strips
- (1) 7-1/2" x WOF strip
- (3) Half strips from the 6-1/2" x WOF strips
- (16) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

### **LIME GREEN**

(6) 3" squares

### **BLACK DOT**

(16) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

### **BLACK SWIRL**

(1) 7-1/2" x WOF strip

### RED

- (1) Half strip from the 6-1/2" x WOF strip
- (1) Half strip from the 2-1/2" x WOF strip

### PRE CLASS PREP - Pin together one of each set -

- (1) White/Gold 6-1/2" half strips
- (1) White/Red 6-1/2" half strips
- (1) Blue/Purple 6-1/2" half strips
- (1) White/Black Swirl 7-1/2" strips
- (1) 2-1/2" half strip of Blue Print/Green Print/White
- (1) 2-1/2" half strip of White/Red/White

### **BLUE**

(1) Half strip from the 6-1/2" x WOF strip

### **PURPLE**

(1) Half strip from the 6-1/2" x WOF strip

### **GOLD**

(1) Half strip from the 6-1/2" x WOF strip

### **BLUE PRINT**

(1) Half strip from the 2-1/2" x WOF strips

### **GREEN PRINT**

(1) Half strip from the 2-1/2" x WOF strip

### **BLACK**

(64) 2-1/2" squares

1/4 yard		Cut in half to (2) 6-1/2" x 20"
BLACK DOT		(3) 6-1/2" x WOF strips
3/4 yard		Cut into (36) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2"
GREEN PRINT		(2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips
1/4 yard		Cut in half to 2-1/2" x 20"
BLUE PRINT		(2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips
1/4 yard		Cut in half to 2-1/2" x 20"
Binding		(6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips

### **MARDI GRAS**

Fabric requirements & pre-cutting for the whole quilt. Bring class requirements from what you have cut out here.

# CUTTING THE WHITE FABRIC STRIPS:

- (4) 6-1/2" x WOF strips From each of these 6-1/2" strips cut one of each 16-1/2" rectangle, 10-1/2" rectangle, 6-1/2" square. Set aside these rectangles for the borders.
- (2) 6-1/2" x WOF strips (16) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles from each strip. These are for the blocks.
- (1) 8-1/2" x *WOF strip* (8) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles and then (4) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles. Set aside the 8-1/2" rectangles for the border units. Add the 6-1/2" rectangles to those you cut above.
- (3) 2-1/2"  $\times$  WOF strips (48) 2-1/2" squares. These are for the block corners.
- (4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips Cut these strips in half to measure 2-1/2" x 20". These are for the center nine patch units.
- (1) 7-1/2" x WOF strip This is for the TOAR.

6-1/2" x 20". These are for the TOAR.

(2) 6-1/2"  $\times$  WOF strips - Cut these strips in half to measure

(1) 4-1/2° x **WOF strip** - Cut this strip into (4) 4-1/2° squares. This is for the block corners.

## PRE CLASS PREP - Pin together one of each set -

- (1) White/Gold 6-1/2" half strips
- (1) White/Red 6-1/2" half strips
- (1) Blue/Purple 6-1/2" half strips
- (1) White/Black Swirl 7-1/2" strips
- (1) 2-1/2" half strip of Blue Print/Green Print/White
- (1) 2-1/2" half strip of White/Red/White
