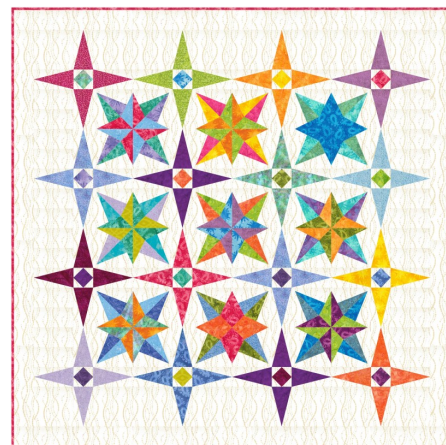


COLOR FUSION

WHOLE QUILT CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS



44" x 44"

Following is the cutting list for the **whole** quilt. You will not complete the whole quilt in the time allotted for the class.

Background (White)	(12) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles (4) 4-1/2" squares	Border 1 Border 1 Corner
2 & 1/2 yards	(128) 2" x 5" rectangles (36) 3-1/2" x 5" rectangles (64) 1-1/2" squares (2) 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips (2) 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" strips	Star Sashing Star Blocks Star Sashing Center Side Borders Top & Bottom Borders
Colors	(16) Sets of (4) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles	Star Sashing
Scraps, 5" strips or a layer cake of 10" squares	(16) 2-1/2" squares (36) Sets of (2) 3-1/2" x 5" rectangles* BRING A FEW EXTRA FOR MORE CHOICES	Sashing Star Center Star Blocks (4 colors per block*)
Binding - 3/8 yard	(5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips	
Backing	(2) cuts of 1-1/2 yards each—seamed vertically There will be enough for a matching hanging sleeve and for long arm quilting	
Batting	Throw size—60 x 60	

FABRIC SUGGESTIONS:

Batiks will work best as it will be easier to flip the pieces in the design. Small to medium prints, no stripes or directionals.

You can cut the "Colors" from a 5" strip.

Bring your extra fabric (from your colors you cut) in case of a mis-cut or misplacement on the foundation.

Other than the background yardage, I used all scraps from my stash.

SUPPLY LIST - HALF DAY WORKSHOP

General Supplies

Machine (***if not provided by the venue***) with a new needle
(don't forget the cord and foot pedal)

1/4" foot on your machine (or know how to move your needle to
set a 1/4" seam)

Neutral color thread on top and in bobbin

Scissors - paper and fabric

Rotary cutting supplies - personal size mat, cutter with a new blade

Small square ruler - I use an Omnigrid 9-1/2" square

Straight pins

Small bag for garbage to tape to table & scotch tape

Marking tool to transfer foundation stencil onto vellum (Pigma Pen, Thin sharpie)



Fabric Requirements

Please have fabrics pre-cut and labelled. These requirements are PER BLOCK. It is estimated you will be able to get two blocks completed in the half day class time allotment.

Border/Sashing Units :

(4) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles of the same color

(8) 2" x 5" rectangles of the background

Star blocks:

(4) Sets of (2) 3-1/2" x 5" rectangles (4 different colors) - each rectangle will be used twice. You may want to bring a few extra for extra color choices and an extra rectangle or two from the colors you choose for miscuts as you learn the technique

(4) 3-1/2" x 5" rectangles of background

Center Sashing Units :

(1) 2-1/2" square of a color

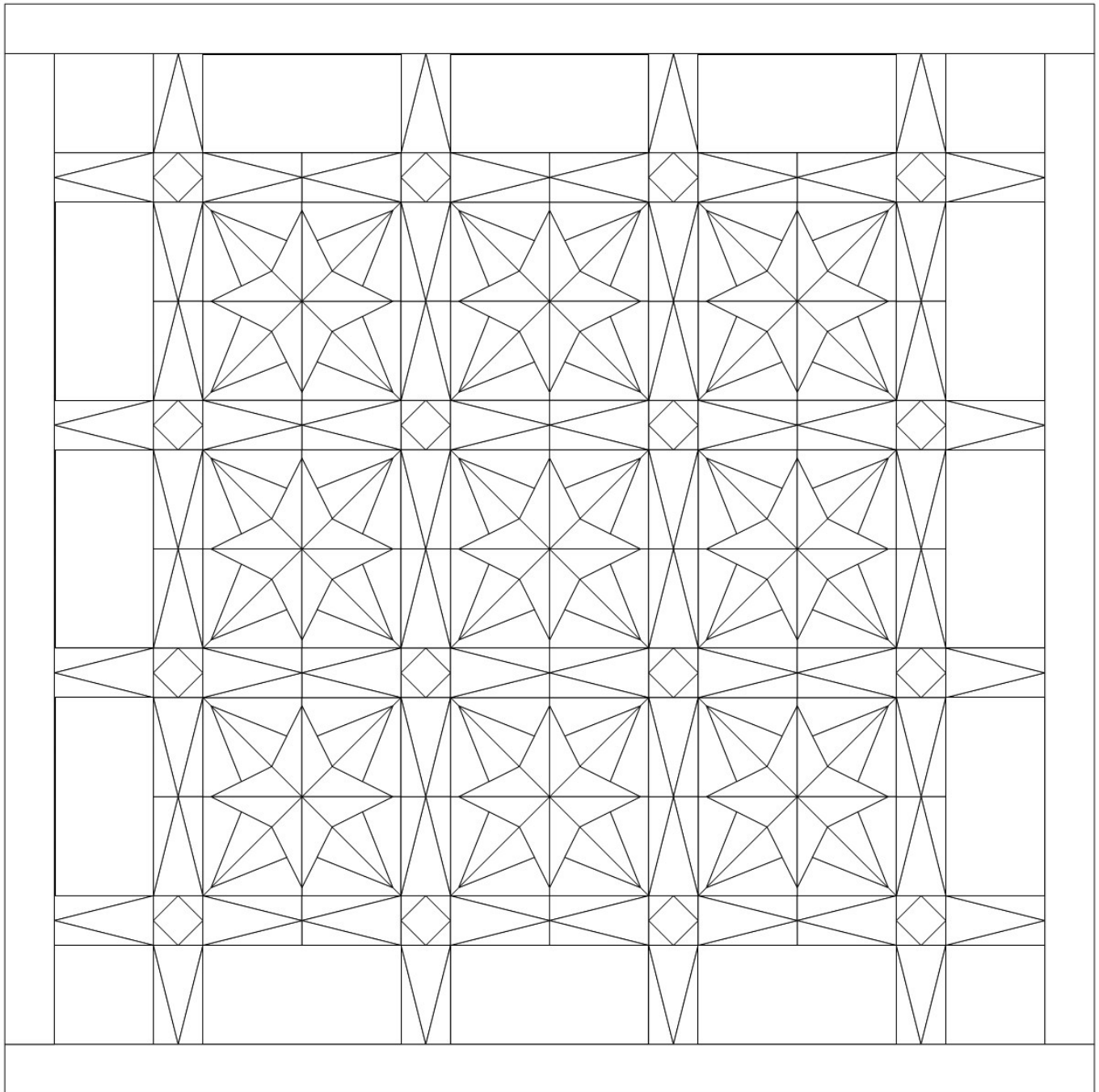
(4) 1-1/2" squares of the background

*Required class kit payable to instructor
in class - includes Full color pattern,
foundation paper and (2) re-useable
foundation piecing stencils*

No fabric included
