Finished size of project: 36" x 36"

## ***HALF DAY class supply list***

### **GENERAL SUPPLIES**

If not provided by hosting venue, your machine, cleaned, oiled and with a new needle

1/4" foot on the machine

Neutral color thread for top and in bobbin

Fabrics - cut and bagged \*please see attached chart

Rotary cutter, personal mat and small **square** (suggest 9-1/2")

Pins, scotch tape

Bag to tape on table for garbage

Your favorite marking tool - (suggest Chaco-Liner)

Optional: 16" piece of batting to lay out block pieces

Optional: Small can/bottle of starch

Peppermint Patties might be nice! :-)



Required class kit includes full color pattern, handout and pre-cut/pre-labelled Triangles on a Roll for the whole project. Cash preferred.

Since this is a half day class, please cut the fabric from the attached supply list (which is for the whole project) and bring what is listed below - which is what I anticipate we will complete in class. If you sew on the faster side, you may wish to bring all your fabrics.

### **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

Please refer to the attached chart for yardage and cutting for the project. If you are using different fabrics, I suggest that you cut a small swatch of your fabric and paste over the corresponding fabric in the cutting chart for easy reference.

### **PRE-CLASS PREP**

After cutting the required fabrics per the cutting chart, please pair (right sides together) and pin the following fabric strips so they are ready to go at class time.

**A/G** (1) 6-1/2" x 18" strip

**A/F** (1) 6-1/2" x 18" strip

**F/G** (1) 6-1/2" x 18" strip

**E/F** (1) 6-1/2" x 12" strip

**C/D** (1) 6-1/2" x 12" strip

**B/H** (1) 6-1/2" x 12" strip

**B/E** (1) 6-1/2" x 3-1/2" strip

#### **In addition to the strips, please also bring:**

FABRIC B (4) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

FABRIC C (8) 2-1/2" squares

FABRIC D (8) 2-1/2" squares

FABRIC E (1) 2-1/2" square

FABRIC G (8) 2-1/2" squares

FABRIC H (4) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

Pre-Washing and/or starching your fabrics prior to class is optional. That said, I am a big fan of starching fabrics before cutting and during the piecing process.








**Fabric Requirements and Cutting**

Place a swatch of the fabric you are using over the corresponding fabric on the cutting chart for easy identification.

For my sample, I used fabric from my Paradise Bay collection from Banyan Batiks by Northcott.

<b>B</b>		1/3 yard	(16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (1) 6-1/2" x WOF	(1) 6-1/2" x 12" - Pair with Fabric H (1) 6-1/2" x 3-1/2" - Pair with Fabric E
<b>C</b>		3/8 yard	(16) 2-1/2" squares (1) 6-1/2" X WOF	(1) 6-1/2" x 12" - Pair with Fabric D
<b>D</b>		3/8 yard	(16) 2-1/2" squares (1) 6-1/2" x WOF	(1) 6-1/2" x 12" - Pair with Fabric C
<b>E</b>		1/3 yard	(4) 2-1/2" squares (10) 3" squares	(1) 6-1/2" x 12" - Pair with Fabric F (1) 6-1/2" x 3-1/2" - Pair with Fabric B
<b>F</b>		1/2 yard	(3) 6-1/2" x 18" (1) 6-1/2" x 12"	(3) 6-1/2" x 18" Pair (1) with Fabric A Pair (2) with Fabric G (1) 6-1/2" x 12" - Pair with Fabric E
<b>G</b>		5/8 yard	(32) 2-1/2" squares	(3) 6-1/2" x 18" Pair (1) with Fabric A Pair (2) with Fabric G
<b>H</b>		1/3	(16) 2-1/2" X 4-1/2"	(1) 6-1/2" x 12 - Pair with Fabric B
Binding	Your Choice	1/2 yard		(5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips
Backing	Your Choice	1 & 1/4 yards		Includes enough for hanging sleeve
