

Indian Blanket Table Runner Class

Student supply list:

- 1 Batik jelly roll (40 2-1/2" strips) in rainbow colors
- 1/2-yard black fabric cut into (5) 2-1/2" x width of fabric strips
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies
- Cutting mat, ruler, and rotary cutter
- Paper bag for trash, scotch tape
- Small travel iron and ironing mat
- Optional: rotating cutting mat

Note: yardage for borders is NOT included here. It will be supplied with the pattern in class.

Pre-Class Cutting List: Do this before you come to class.

1. From the 2-1/2" black strips cut (68) 60° diamonds. Print out the diamond template, carefully cut it out on the outer cutting lines, and tape it to the back of a ruler as shown in Fig. 1.
2. Open out the black strips and stack up two more strips with the edges perfectly aligned.
3. Place the template & ruler on the black strip and align 2 opposite sides of the diamond template with the top and bottom of the strip. Cut the strip along the left side of the ruler as shown in Fig. 1.
4. **Turn the ruler 180° to the right.** Re-align the template with the top and bottom of the strip, and the left side with the previous cut. Now cut the right side of the diamond shape as shown in Fig. 2.
5. Slide the ruler down the strip aligning the left side of the template with the previous cut, and cut along the right side of the template. You should be able to cut 12-13 diamonds from each strip.

From the jelly roll, select the following colors and pin a label to each one with the names shown in the Cutting Chart (below). If you choose different colors, label the strip with the old and new colors.

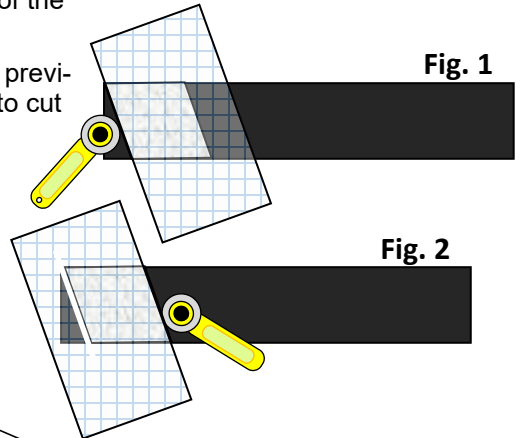
